COOKIES POLICY

Our website – like many others - uses cookies in order to give you the best possible experience on our online pages. Cookies allow our website to ‘remember’ you, either for the duration of your visit by using a ‘session cookie’ or for repeat visits using a ‘persistent cookie’.

Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, store your preferences and make everything much faster and easier. If a website doesn’t use cookies, it will think you are a new visitor every time you move to a new page on the site.

Cookies also allow us to target our advertising and marketing messages effectively – based on your location or browsing habits – and this means we can send you information which we know will be of interest.

Cookies can be set by the website you are visiting (‘first party cookies’) or can be set by other websites who run content on the page you are viewing (‘third party cookies’).

What is a cookie made up of?

A cookie is a simple text file, sent to your computer or mobile device by our server. Once the cookie has been stored on your system, only that server will be able to read the unique contents of that cookie. It contains anonymous information such as the site name and some numbers. It allows our website to remember your preferences.

How to remove cookies

If you find the idea of a website storing information on your computer or mobile device a bit intrusive and you prefer not to see advertising that has been targeted to your interests, it is possible to block some or all cookies. You can also delete cookies that have already been set if you prefer to do so; but you may lose some functions of that website.
